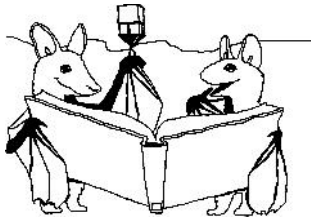
Daring Dreamers

- Read any books or magazines.
- Read to yourself or to someone else.
- Listen to audiobooks.
- Listen to someone else reading to you.

Everyone may participate in our Summer Reading Program. You do not need a library card to read, earn prizes, or attend programs. (You only need a card to check out books and other items from the library.)

You may choose to count how much time you read or how many days you read. Earn prizes and enter the prize drawing after reading for 5, 10, and 15 hours or 10, 20, and 30 days. Continue to enter the prize drawing for every additional 5 hours or 10 days you read.

Friday, June 8 is the first day to register for the Summer Reading Program and pick up a reading log.

Monday, June 18 is the first day to show us your reading logs and earn prizes.

Friday, August 10 is the last day to enter the prize drawing.
