Children are invited to read or listen to books, earn prizes, and attend programs at the library this summer.

Pick up a reading log from the library to keep track of your reading and listening.

- Read books, ebooks, or magazines.
- Read to yourself or to someone else.
- Listen to audiobooks.
- Listen to someone else reading to you.

You may choose to count how many hours you read or how many days you read.

Earn prizes after you have read for 5, 10, and 15 hours or 10, 20, and 30 days. Enter the prize drawing for additional hours or days that you read.

You may also choose an activity log of reading activities to explore throughout the summer.

Wednesday, June 15 is the first day to pick up a reading log from the library.

Monday, June 27 is the first day to receive prizes.

Saturday, August 6 is the last day to receive prizes and enter the prize drawing for the **reading logs**.

Saturday, September 3 is the last day to receive prizes and enter the prize drawing for the **activity logs**.
